Goto Default Manager -> Inventory -> Banners -> Banner Properties -> Delivery Option .

Select ' **Geo country/city** ' from Add delivery limitation Dropdown and click on Add button. Set your targeting for country and select multiple city .If the banner limited by particular city,banner will deliver specified city only.
